## 1. Abrasive Wheels Training

Safety, Health and Welfare at Work (General Application) (Amendment) Regulations 2016 amended the 2007 Regulations, i.e. introducing a new part 12 ‘Abrasive Wheels’. This course is legally required for all those who are involved in the purchase & selection, storage & handling, mounting, dressing and use of abrasive wheels. This includes fixed (e.g. Bench grinders) and portable (e.g. angle grinders) abrasive wheels.

<p><b>Duration</b> This course is 3.5 hours long with a maximum of 12 participants.</p>	<p><b>Fees</b> Available upon request</p>
<p><b>Objectives</b> This course applies to an employer in respect of the use of any abrasive wheel for any grinding or cutting operation at a place of work for which the employer has responsibility under the Act or these Regulations. This course enables employees to;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Safely store and identify abrasive wheels</li> <li>• Select the appropriate wheel</li> <li>• Inspect and recognise damaged wheels</li> <li>• Ensure guards are in place</li> <li>• Competent to mount an abrasive wheel</li> <li>• Understand the hazards and risks when using abrasive wheels</li> </ul>	
<p><b>Course Content</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Abrasive wheels 2016 regulations</li> <li>• Identifying the hazards working with abrasive wheels</li> <li>• Storage of abrasive wheels</li> <li>• Selecting the correct abrasive wheel, e.g. metal, stone, for the job</li> <li>• Inspection &amp; testing of abrasive wheels – e.g. ring test</li> <li>• Guards</li> <li>• Dressing and truing of abrasive wheels</li> <li>• Functions of the different components, e.g. flanges, blotters etc.</li> <li>• Differences between grinding and cutting operations</li> <li>• Safe mounting of the abrasive wheel</li> </ul>
