1. Fire Warden Training

Two pieces of legislation deal with the legal obligations of employers with regard to fire safety and emergencies in the workplace, namely;

The Fire Services Act 1981 refers to *“18(2) It shall be the duty of every person having control over premises to which this section applies to take all reasonable measures to guard against the outbreak of fire on such premises, and to ensure as far as is reasonably practicable the safety of persons on the premises in the event of an outbreak of fire”* and

The Health, Safety and Welfare at Work Act 2005, *“11(a) provide the necessary measures to be taken appropriate to the place of work for first aid, fire-fighting and the evacuation of employees and any other individual present in the place of work, taking account of the nature of the work being carried on and the size of the place of work”*.

This course enables those designated by the employer, i.e. fire wardens, to be component in evacuation etc.
