## 1. Management Safety Training

The 4 day Institute of Occupational Safety and Health (IOSH) accredited Managing Safely course is intended for those required to manage safely and effectively in compliance the Health, Safety and Welfare at Work Act 2005, in particular;

*“...Section 8(2)(a) managing and conducting work activities in such a way as to ensure, so far as is reasonably practicable, the safety, health and welfare at work of his or her employees;  
(b) managing and conducting work activities in such a way as to prevent, so far as is reasonably practicable, any improper conduct or behaviour likely to put the safety, health or welfare at work of his or her employees at risk;...”*

This affords the opportunity for employers/managers to adhere to both their organisation’s policy and best practice in health and safety. The course is designed to give employers/managers the basic knowledge and skill needed to conform to section 8 as set out above.

<p><b>Objectives</b> Participants will be enabled to understand their responsibilities in accordance with section 8 of the 2005 Act, have the competencies to manage health, safety and welfare issues in the workplace.</p> <p>They will be able to implement risk assessment and control measure strategies taking account of in-house and/or external competent people, e.g. safety consultants. They will have an understanding of health, safety and welfare requirements in the workplace. Participants will have a basic understanding of the 2007 Regulations with regard to common hazards including; fire, electricity, working at height, stress, noise, vibration, manual handling, chemicals and workplace transport, driving for work, first aid.</p> <p>Employers and managers will find it enables you to investigate incidents and empowers you to measure your own performance.</p>
